- Letter size:
 - a. When letters are all uppercase, use series "E"
 - b. When initial upper case letter is used in conjunction with lowercase letters, use series "Ë" (M) for uppercase letter.
- 2. All signs shall conform to Section 621 of the Special Provisions and the latest editions and amendments of the following FHWA publications:
 - a. "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways" (MUTCD)
 - b. "Standard Highway Signs"
 - c. "Standard Alphabets for Highway Signs"
- 3. Borders, messages, arrows, symbols, and shield shall conform to details as shown on the plans and as specified in the MUTDC.
- 4. Sign messages shall be as indicated on the plan.
- 5. All panels shall be reflectorized in accordance with Section 712.20 of the Standard Specifications. Minimum width of panels shall be 2 ft. Abutting edges of panels shall be in only one direction. If vertical abutting edges are used, no horizontal abutting edges shall be allowed and vice versa.
- 6. Contractor shall submit all sign splicing details to the Engineer for approval. All backing for signs 4 feet by 6 feet shall be of one sheet.
- 7. Paint all Sign Posts with yellow reflective paint. This work is considered as incidental to sign items.
- \triangle 8. Existing signs not shown on these plans or listed in the Sign Schedule shall remain as posted unless otherwise directed by the Engineer.
- 1 9. All signs, sign panels, markers, posts, and anchors removed shall be disposed of by the Contractor. Removal and disposal work shall be considered incidental to the various sign items and no separate payment shall be provided.
- \triangle 10. Final locations of all signs shall be approved by the Engineer prior to any installation work.
- 11. Except for speed limit signs, all new signs and sign panels shall be identical to the existing sign that they replace. The Contractor shall submit Shop Drawings to the Engineer for approval prior to fabricating the sign.
- 12. New Speed Limit signs shall be 36"x 48" and installed on two posts. New Reduced Speed and Minimum Speed signs shall be 24"x 30" size signs.
- \triangle 13. All signs greater than 10 square feet shall be installed with two posts. M-3, M-5, and M-12 signs are listed on the schedule as greater than 10 square feet because these signs are intended to be installed with two posts and shall be paid for accordingly.
- 14. All signs shall be installed with square tube posts, unless otherwise noted.
- 15. Destination sign panels shall be installed on existing breakaway sign posts. The posts shall be prepared for painting (rust removed, sanded) and shall be painted with yellow reflective paint. This work shall be considered incidental to the sign panel pay item.
- 16. After removing existing sign posts, backfill post holes with selected material free of rock and accepted by the Engineer. Place backfill in layers and compact each layer as accepted by the Engineer. Grade and compact before resetting existing posts and installing new posts.
- $/\!\!\! \bigwedge$ 17. Unless otherwise specified, installation of all new signs shown on the schedules shall be paid for as regulatory or warning signs.
