

## TYPICAL PAVEMENT DETAIL

- 1. Improvements consists of Reconstructing and Resurfacing the existing Pavement, Installing Pavement Markers, Adjusting Water Volve Boxes and Centerline & Survey Monuments.
- 2. Asphalt Concrete for Leveling Course shall be paid for under Item No. 401.0500-Asphalt Concrete Pavement, Mix No. I.
- 3. Tack Coat shall be incidental to Item No. 401.0500 Asphalt
- 4. All Construction Signs shall be Reflectorized with High
- 5. Pavement Area to be Striped shall be Broomed Off by the Contractor prior to Striping by the State.
- 6. Construct Smooth and Easy Riding Connections to existing Roadway at the Beginning and Ending of Project.
- 7. Existing Pavement Surface Variable. Surface indicated here is not intended to represent any specific location.
- 8. Preparation of Shoulder Areas for Paving shall be done
- 9. All Centerline and Reference Survey Monuments were based on "As-Built" Plans. The actual Number of Monuments to be Adjusted shall be determined in the field.
- 10. Construction Warning Signs Paid for under Item No. 621.7120 shall be Removed by the Contractor and Delivered to the Highway Maintenance Baseyard location designated by the Engineer, upon Completion of the Project.
- 11. Blue Reflective Pavement Markers used to mark Fire Hydrant locations shall be Provided by the State for Installation by the Contractor; Work shall be considered Incidental to Contract Items and No Separate Payment shall be
