## GENERAL NOTES

- I. Improvements consist of widening the existing pavement, adjusting water valve boxes and removing existing pavement markers and striping, and installing new markers.
- 2. Tack Coat shall be incidental to Item No. 401.0500-Asphalt Concrete Pavement, Mix No. I.
- 3. Asphalt Concrete for leveling shall be paid for under Item No. 401.0500 Asphalt Concrete Pavement, Mix No. I.
- 4. All construction signs shall be reflectorized with high intensity reflective sheeting.
- 5. Existing pavement surface variable. Surface indicated on Typical Sections is not intended to represent any specific location.
- 6. Smooth and easy riding connections shall be constructed at the begin and end of project limits and at the end of each work day.
- 7. All lanes shall be open to traffic during morning peak hours from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. and during the afternoon peak hours from 3:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. and during off-work hours or as directed by the Engineer. Only one lane of the highway shall be closed during work hours.
- 8. During work stoppages and non-working hours, the Contractor shall restore to smooth-riding condition all pavement drop-offs located within four feet of the travelway.
- 9. Access from existing sideroads and/or driveways shall be provided and maintained by the Contractor at all times unless otherwise directed by the Engineer.
