SIGN NOTES

- 1. Letter Size:
 - a. When letters are all uppercase, use series "E"
 - b. When initial uppercase letter is used in conjunction with lowercase letters, use series "E" (M) for uppercase letter.
- 2. All signs shall conform to Section 621 of the Special Provisions and the latest editions and amendments of the following FHWA publications:
 - a. "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways" (MUTCD)
 - b. "Standard Highway Signs"
 - c. "Standard Alphabets for Highway Signs"
- 3. Borders, messages, arrows, symbols and shield shall conform to details as shown on the plans and as specified in the MUTCD.
- 4. Sign messages shall be as indicated on the plan.
- 5. All panels shall be reflectorized in accordance with Section 712.20 of the Standard Specifications. Minimum width of panels shall be 2 ft. abutting edges of panels shall be in only one direction if vertical abutting edges are used, no horizontal abutting edges shall be allowed and vice versa.
- 6. Contractor shall submit all sign splicing details to the Engineer for approval.

 All backing for signs 4 feet by 6 feet or less shall be of one sheet.
- 7. D-5 signs shall be measured for payment under Item No. 621.5000, Regulatory and Warning Sign (10 square feet or less).
- 8. Sign posts shall be painted with yellow reflective paint, except where located behind guardrails. Such paint work shall be considered incidental to sign items.
- 9. Unless otherwise noted all sign posts to be galvanized metal square tube sign posts, as per State Standards.
- O. Final locations of all signs shall be approved by the Engineer prior to any installation work.
- II. Existing signs not shown on these plans shall remain as posted unless otherwise directed by the Engineer. Removal and disposal of existing signs and/or posts as designated on these plans shall be incidental to the various signing items.
- 12. D-1 to D-4 signs shall be Reflectorized Silver on Green Background .
- 13. For Sign Locations see Sheet Nos. 19 21.
- 14. Contractor shall mark the backs of all signs using labels and equipment provided by the State. Payment to be incidental to various Contract Items.
- 15. Destination sign panels shall be installed on existing posts, unless otherwise called for on the plans.
