


RUMBLE STRIP DETAIL

4" Yellow Stripe Thermoplastic Extrusion or Tape, Type I

Transverse Right Shoulder Marking: 4" White Stripe (Thermoplastic Extrusion) With Type "C" Reflective Markers 10' O.C.

Diagonal 12" White Stripe (Thermoplastic Extrusion) Spaced @ 10' O.C.

Pavement Markings and Striping Notes:

- 1. Layout of pavement markings and striping shall be done by the Contractor and approved by the Engineer prior to any installation work.
- Existing pavement markings not incorporated in the final traffic pattern shall be removed as directed by the Engineer. Costs shall be incidental to the various pavement marking items.
- Final locations of all Stop Bars shall be approved by the Engineer prior to installation.
- All pavement striping shall be as noted on the Legend or plans.
- All preformed pavement marking tapes over existing pavement shall be applied with an approved primer as recommended by the tape manufacturer and as approved by the Engineer. The primer shall be allowed to dry to a tacky stage prior to tape application.
- Contractor shall obtain blue raised pavement markers from County of Hawaii Fire Department and install them adjacent to existing fire hydrants at the direction of the Engineer. The cost of installing these markers shall be incidental to other Contract Items.
- 7. All striping shall conform to the Standard Plans, unless ohterwise approved by the Engineer.

Signing Notes:

- 1. Existing signs not shown on these plans shall be removed unless otherwise directed by the Engineer. Removal and disposal of existing signs and/or posts as shown on these plans or as directed by the Engineer, shall be incidental to the various signing items.
- All signs and posts removed are the property of the State, Contractor shall be responsible for stockpiling material at location designated by the Engineer. This work shall be considered incidental to various signing items and no separate payment shall be provided.
- 3. Final locations of all signs shall be approved by the Engineer prior to any installation work.
- All sign posts for regulatory and warning signs shall be galvanized square tube sign post mountings in accordance with TE-03 of the Standard Plans.
- Sign posts shall painted with yellow reflective paint, except where located behind guard rails. Such paint work shall be considered incidental to the various signing pay items.


