

1. Contractor shall protect existing roadway, walls, guardrail etc. with rubber mats, barriers or other acceptable means prior to beginning operations to protect and prevent damage to existing facilities from falling rocks.

After completion of excavation and acceptance by the Engineer, the Contractor shall provide and install six (6) each of Portable Concrete Barrier (Item No. 606.4160).

- 3. The Contractor shall provide and install one (1) NCHRP Compliant End Treatment (Item No. 606.6000) "N-E-A-T System as manufactured by Energy Absorption Systems, Inc. or approved equal" attached at each end per manufacture instructions.
- The Engineer will pay for the accepted barrier and end treatment at the contract unit price complete in place. The price includes full compensation for material, preparation, installation and furnishing labor, tools, equipment and incidentals to complete the work
- 5. Refer to sheets 9 thru sheets 13 for scope of excavation work.
