SIGN NOTES

- The Contractor shall replace all existing signs (including destination signs), posts, and anchors within the project limits, unless otherwise shown on the plans.
- Lettering
 - a. Destination Signs: Capitals, 8" Modified Series "E"; Lowercase, 6" Modified Series "E".
 - b. Street Name and Supplemental Street Name Signs: Use Modified Series "E", unless otherwise specified by the Engineer.
- All signs shall conform to Section 621 of the Special Provisions and the latest editions and amendments of the following FHWA publications:
 - "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways" (MUTCD)
 - b. "Standard Highway Signs"
 - c. "Standard Alphabets for Highway Signs"
- Borders, messages, arrows, symbols and shield shall conform to details as shown on the plans and as specified in the MUTCD.
- Sign messages shall be as indicated on existing signs, or as directed by the Engineer.
- All panels shall be reflectorized in accordance with Section 712.20 of the Standard Specifications. Minimum width of panels shall be 2 ft. abutting edges of panels shall be in only one direction if vertical abutting edges are used, no horizontal abutting edges shall be allowed and vice versa.
- Contractor shall submit all sign splicing details to the Engineer for acceptance. All backing for signs 4 feet by 6 feet or less shall be of one sheet.
- Backing for all new Regulatory and Warning Signs shall not be spliced.
- Final locations of all signs shall be approved by the Engineer prior to any installation work.
- Existing signs that are to be replaced shall not be removed until new signs are installed as replacements, or the messages are no longer necessary.
- Existing signs not shown on these plans shall remain as posted unless otherwise directed by the Engineer. Removal and disposal of existing signs and/or posts as designated on these plans or as directed by the Engineer shall be considered incidental to the various signing items.
- Removal and Replacement of Existing Delineators and Posts shall be considered incidental to the various signing items.
- All Destination, Street Name, Supplemental Street Name, and Non-Standard signs that are to be replaced shall be identical to the existing sign in size and text, unless otherwise specified.
- All signs, except Destination Signs, shall be installed on square tube posts, unless otherwise noted.
- Sign posts shall be painted with yellow reflective paint, except where located behind guardrails. Such paint work shall be considered incidental to sign items.
- Contractor shall mark the back of all signs using labels and equipment provided by the State. Payment to be incidental to various contract items.
- The Contractor shall submit Shop Drawings to the Engineer for acceptance prior to fabricating Destination, Street Name, Supplemental Street Name, and Non-Standard signs.
- Fabrication and installation of Supplemental Street Name signs (D3-2) shall be considered incidental to installation of W1-2 and W2-2 signs, as applicable.

- Street Name signs shall be paid for under Item No. 621.5000 Regulatory and Warning Sign (10 Square Feet or Less) Without Posts.
- Street Name sign D3-1 shall be paid for under item 621.5000 Regulatory and Warning Sign (10 square feet or less) w/out Posts.
- Foundations and posts for Destination Signs shall be reused, except for square tube posts.
- Square tube sign posts required for the installation of destination signs shall be considered incidental to Item No. 621.0200 - Panel for Destination Sign
- W1-8 signs shall be installed with its face perpendicular to the roadway centerline.
- Removed Signs and Posts are to be delivered from the project to the Hilo Baseyard (50 Makaala Street) by the Contractor. Payment shall be considered incidental to the various items.
- RM-3's shall be provided on all sign posts. The Engineer will consider the cost included in the price of the various contract items.
