6 Site Laboratory and 699 - Mobilization for the limitation of the amount bidders are
7 allowed to bid.

9 If the bid price for any proposal item having a maximum allowable bid
10 indicated therefore in any of the contract documents is in excess of such a
11 maximum amount, the bid price for such proposal item shall be adjusted to reflect
12 the limitation thereon. The comparison of bids to determine the successful
13 bidder and the amount of contract to be awarded shall be determined after such
14 adjustments are made, and such adjustments shall be binding upon the bidder.

16 The bidder is directed to Section 717 – Cullet and Cullet-Made Materials
17 regarding recycling of waste glass.

19 **INSTRUCTIONS TO COMPUTE THE AMOUNT FOR COMPARISON OF BIDS**

22 Each bidder shall indicate its intention to furnish foreign steel on this
23 project by initialing after the AMOUNT for each of the items the bidder intends to
24 use such foreign steel including lump sum items. A bidder not indicating such
25 usage certifies that the bidder will furnish and use only domestic steel on this
26 project. Also, the bidder shall add an additional 25% to the SUM OF ALL ITEMS
27 if the bid submitted is based on furnishing foreign steel in excess of the minimal
28 use specified in Subsection 106.11 - Steel and Iron Construction Material.
