



TYPICAL TANGENT SECTION Not To Scale




TYPICAL SUPERELEVATED SECTION

GENERAL NOTES:

- 1. Improvements consists of Resurfacing the existing pavement, installing Pavement Markers and Reconstructing Centerline and Reference Survey Monuments.
- 2. Asphalt Concrete for Leveling Course shall be Paid for under Item No. 401.0500 Asphalt Concrete Pavement, Mix No. I.
- 3. Tack Coat shall be incidental to Item No. 401.0500 Asphalt Concrete Pavement, Mix No. V.
- 4. All Construction Signs shall be Reflectorized with High Intensity Reflective Sheeting.
- 5. Pavement Areas to be Striped shall be Broomed Off By Contractor Prior to Striping By the State.
- 6. Construct Smooth and Easy Riding Connections to existing roadway at Beginning and End of Project.
- 7. Existing pavement surface variable. Surface indicated here is not intended to represent any specific location.
- 8. Preparation of Shoulder Areas for Paving shall be done By the State.
