The following amendments shall be made to the Bid Documents:

A. NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Prospective bidders are hereby notified that receiving of sealed proposals scheduled for October 6, 2016, will be postponed and rescheduled for 2:00 PM, October 13, 2016.

B. SPECIFICATIONS

1. Amend Special Provisions Subsection 627.03(B) – Contractor Qualifications, by revising lines 33 to 37 to read as follows:

“(B) Contractor Qualifications. The Contractor responsible for sculpting the textured shotcrete wall facing shall provide a project reference list verifying the successful construction completion of at least five (5) projects totaling no less than 25,000 Sq. Ft. of sculpted rock facing. The Contractor shall provide photos of each of the five projects.”

2. Amend Special Provisions Subsection 627.03(B) – Contractor Qualifications, by revising lines 45 to 48 to read as follows:

“The Contractor shall submit a signed statement of experience certifying the Contractor is an established business with a minimum of five (5) years experience and indicate in detail experience in successfully constructing sculpted shotcrete walls.”


