- Contractor Shall Be Responsible For Locating And Protecting All Existing Utilities.
- All Newly Grassed Areas Not Provided With An Automatic Irrigation System Shall Receive A Temporary Surface Irrigation System For Grass Establishment.
- Notify And Meet With The Engineer Prior To Plant Installation For Verification/Interpretation Of Plans.
- Notify Engineer Of Any Discrepancies In Plant Locations Or Insufficient Plant Quantities Due To Differences In Plan And Actual Field Conditions.
- Notify Engineer 30 Days Prior To Planting Operations For Approval Of All Plant Material At Place Of Growth. All Plant Material Not Approved By The Engineer Will Be Subject To Rejection.
- The Contractor Shall Flag All Plant Locations And Lay Out All Groundcover And Grass Areas Prior To Installation For Approval By Engineer. Notify Engineer (5) Working Days In Advance.
