


PORTABLE BARRIER



NOTES:

- Physical barriers shall be required whenever guardrails have been removed and will not be reinstalled at the end of the work day. See note 18 of General Notes (Plan Sheet Number 3).
- Physical barriers shall be either portable concrete barriers or portable water filled barriers.
- Providing, transporting, placing, maintaining, relocating and removal of physical barriers shall be considered incidental to the various items of work. See Section 645, TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES of the Special Provisions.
- The State will provide to the contractor, at no cost, portable concrete barriers available at the Kapaa Baseyard. The Contractor shall be responsible for hauling barrier panels from the Baseyard, furnishing the pins required to pin the panels to each other as shown on Standard Plan TE-64, installing reflector markers (RM-3) over the concrete barriers, and cleaning and hauling the panels back to the Kapaa Baseyard upon completion of the project
- 5. Portable barriers available from the State shall be limited to the following:

LENGTH NUMBER 12'-6" 16 20'-0" 20

6. If additional Portable Barriers are required, it shall be the Contractor's responsibility to supply them as stipulated in note 3.
