Responses to HIePRO Questions for solicitation B23001703 Installation of Enhanced Pavement Marking and New Milled Rumble Strip at Various Locations, Island of Kauai Project No. HSIP-0700(091)

1. Can you provide a detail for the Thermoplastic Rumble Bars item 629.1150 on proposal sheet P-9?

RESPONSE: See Addendum No. 1 for detail.

2. What happens if we are unable to obtain a noise variance permit for the equipment required to perform eradication and milled rumble strips? The application for the noise variance permit mentions paying for publication and circulation of public notices and public hearings, which could end up costing many thousands of dollars. Can this be added as a bid item in the proposal?

RESPONSE: Costs for obtaining the noise variance permit shall be incidental to the project. If the noise variance is unattainable, the Engineer will work with the Contractor to find a solution to complete the work.

3. What is the difference between 629.1140 - Crosswalk Marking (Thermoplastic Extrusion) (1 – 191 LN) and 629.1142 Crosswalk Marking (Thermoplastic Extrusion) (Crosswalks Only) (100 – 400 LN)? The quantities overlap.

RESPONSE: Item 629.1142: Crosswalk Marking (Thermoplastic Extrusion) (Crosswalks Only) will be used when issuing a work order containing only crosswalk marking and associated stop bar striping and crosswalk and stop bar removal work around the island. Other items used for crosswalk only and associated stop bar work orders include 629.1052: 12-Inch Pavement Striping (Thermoplastic Extrusion) (Stop Bar at Crosswalks Only), 629.3152: Removing and Disposing of Existing Pavement Striping (Stop Bar at Crosswalks Only), and 629.3152: Removing and Disposing of Existing Crosswalk Markings (Crosswalks Only).

Item 629.1140: Crosswalk Marking (Thermoplastic Extrusion) will be used if crosswalk markings are being installed as part of a contiguous pavement marking and/or milled rumble strip work order.

4. Will some day-work be allowed, for example, the installation of BMPs?

RESPONSE: Day work is permissible when approved by the Engineer. Typically, day work is allowed if no lane closures are needed for the work. Day work involving lane closures will need to be evaluated.

5. I want to confirm that all surveying will be done on a force account basis.

RESPONSE: All surveying necessary to complete the work order will be done on a force account basis.

6. Is work halted between September 15th and January 1st to account for the seabird busy season and the Holiday no-work period?

RESPONSE: Night work will be suspended from September 15th to December 15th each year for the shearwater fledgling season. Suspension of work during the holiday period is dependent on the directive given each year.

7. The section "SECTION 671 – PROTECTION OF THREATENED AND ENDANGERED SPECIES" call for training, and procedures to account for the potential of a downed seabird. I assume these costs will be paid out of 671.1000 Protection of Threatened and Endangered Species?

RESPONSE: Yes, Section 671 will be paid on a force account basis.

8. There isn't a bid item for the layout. How will this cost be accounted for? In areas, without eradication, the existing stripes can be striped over but in eradicated areas or those with a change in configuration, layout will be required.

RESPONSE: Layout done by a surveyor will be paid on a force account basis.
