3 **SECTION 691 – ARCHAEOLOGICAL MONITORING**
4

5 **691.01 Description.** This work includes monitoring construction activity for
6 archaeological items at the location shown on the plans and as directed by the
7 Engineer.
8

9 An archaeological monitoring plan has been submitted and written acceptance with
10 comments has been provided by the State Department of Land and Natural Resources,
11 State Historic Preservation Division. Copies of the accepted archaeological monitoring
12 plan are on file at the office of the Engineer.
13

14 **691.02 Materials.** None.
15

16 **691.03 Construction.** In addition to the requirements of Section 107.13 (B) –
17 Archaeological, Historical, and Burial Site Findings, from Mile Post 6.18 to Mile Post
18 6.53 of Route 56, Kuhio Highway, and from Mile Post 0.04 to Mile Post 3.91 of Route
19 580, Kuamoo Road, the Contractor shall obtain the services of a qualified Archaeologist
20 or firm to investigate the sites prior to clearing and grubbing and to monitor construction
21 activities during clearing and grubbing and/or drilling and excavation activities for
22 historic remains such as artifacts, burials, concentrations of shell or charcoal.

24 If remains are found, work shall cease in the immediate vicinity of the find and the find
25 shall be protected from further damage. The Contractor shall immediately contact the
26 State Historic Preservation Division (692-8015), which will assess the significance of the
27 find and recommend appropriate mitigation measures, if necessary.
28

29 **691.04 Measurement.** The Engineer will measure the work required for the
30 archaeological monitoring, including remedial measures, on a force account basis in
31 accordance with Subsection 109.06 – Force Account Provisions and Compensation and
32 as ordered by the Engineer.
33

34 **691.05 Payment.** The Engineer will pay for the accepted archaeological monitoring,
35 including remedial measures, on a force account basis in accordance with Subsection
36 109.06 – Force Account Provisions and Compensation. Payment will be full
37 compensation for the work prescribed in this section, by the Engineer, and in the
38 contract documents.

40 The Engineer will pay for the following pay item when included in the proposal
41 schedule:

47 The Engineer will not pay for work required that is due to the Contractor's
48 convenience, negligence, carelessness or failure to properly monitor excavation activity.
