
GENERAL NOTES:

- The scope of work for this project consists of Fog Sealing the Kaumualii Hwy. travelways between Mahaikona Bridge to Lele Road.
- 2 The Contractor's attention is directed to Subsection 107.13 Public Convenience and Safety: Section 645 Traffic Control and Subsection 107.21 Contractor's Responsibility for Utility Property and Service of the Special Provisions.
- 3 At the end of each day's work, the Contractor shall remove all equipment and other obstructions to permit free and safe passage of public traffic.
- 4 The exact locations and limits or areas to be Fog Sealed shall be determined in the field by the Engineer.
- 5 The Contractor shall notify the State in writing, two (2) weeks prior to starting paving operations.
- 6 The Contractor shall keep at least one lane open to traffic during working hours and both lanes open during non-working hours. All lanes shall be open to traffic during peak hours from 6:00 a.m. to 8:30a.m. and 3:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- 7- The Contractor shall be held liable for any damages incurred to the existing highway and utility facilities as the result of his operations.

 All damaged portions shall be repaired and or replaced in accordance with the Standard Specifications of the State and/or the affected Utility Company.
