The project includes construction of an intersection “roundabout”, realigning adjacent roadways; cold planning (as needed); asphalt concrete pavement overlay resurfacing; installing a new temporary steel frame bridge, street lighting, drainage improvements and curb ramps; removing existing and installing new guardrails and terminal sections, pavement markings, signs and chain link fences; and removal of existing concrete pavement.

Plans and specifications may be examined and borrowed at the appropriate offices. Borrowed plans and specifications shall be returned in good condition within 30 calendar days after the bid opening date.

A pre-bid conference is set for 1:00 p.m., May 12, 2004, at the Kauai District Office, 3060 Eiwa Street, Lihue, Kauai, Conference Rooms A & B (2nd

Floor). All prospective bidders or their representatives (employees) are encouraged to attend, but attendance is not mandatory.

To be eligible to bid, bidders must possess a valid State of Hawaii General Engineering Contractor's "A" license.

Each proposal shall be on a form furnished by said Department.


Estimated construction cost is between \$ 2.5 Million and \$ 3 Million.
