

A compact disc containing the plans, specifications, proposal and contract forms may be obtained from the above offices. Bids (hard copies) shall be submitted in a sealed envelope, and shall be on the Proposal Form provided on the compact disc furnished by said Department. Bids received after the established due date and time will not be considered.

The project includes removal of invasive trees, installation of new landscaping, and removal of invasive tree saplings for one (1) year. Estimated construction cost is between \$2,000,000 and \$4,000,000.

To be eligible to bid, bidders must possess a valid State of Hawaii General Engineering "A" license or Specialty Contractor's "C-27" license, prior to bidding. The Hawaii Products Preference pursuant to Act 175, SLH 2009, is applicable to this project.

Persons wishing to certify and qualify a product as a Hawaii Product shall submit a Certification for Hawaii Product Preference (SPO- Form 38) to the DOT Contracts office no later than 4:30 P.M., fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the bid opening date. Late submittals for this project will not be reviewed by the DOT. A separate SPO-Form 38 shall be completed and submitted for each product. A 5% bid adjustment for bidders that are parties to apprenticeship agreements pursuant to Section 103-55.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), is applicable to this project.

Compliance with Act 68, SLH 2010 is a requirement whereby a minimum of 80% of the bidder's work force on this project **must** consist of Hawaii residents.

A pre-bid conference is set for 9:00 A.M., January 8, 2014 at the office of the District Engineer – Kauai, 1720 Haleukana Street, Lihue, Hawaii 96766. All prospective bidders or their representatives (employees) are encouraged to attend, but attendance is not mandatory. Campaign contributions by State and County Contractors.
