



BIOSOCK COMPOST FILTER SOCK NOTES:

- 1. Remove accumulated sediment when the depth reaches $\frac{1}{3}$ of the barrier height.
- 2. Biosock material and compost shall be removed at the completion of construction (or a phase of construction) and shall be disposed of properly.
- 3. No staking is required for slopes < 4:1.
- 4. Compost shall not contain biosolids and should be consistent with United States Environmental Protection Agency guidelines






TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION STABILIZATION Not to Scale

GENERAL NOTES


- 1. Contractor shall extend biosock limits to cover full length of storage/staging areas at no additional cost to the State. Biosocks shown on plans are minimum.
- 2. No vehicles, equipment or material shall be stored or parked on either of the Wailua River Bridges.
