3.0 If a discrepancy occurs between unit bid price and the bid price, the unit bid price shall govern.

**NOTE: Bidders shall submit and upload the complete proposal to HlePRO prior to the bid opening date and time. Proposals received after said due date and time shall not be considered. Original (wet ink, hard copy) proposal documents are not required to be submitted. Contract award shall be based on evaluation of proposals submitted and uploaded to HlePRO. Any additional support documents explicitly designated as confidential and/or proprietary shall be uploaded as a separate file to HlePRO. Do not include confidential and/or proprietary documents with the proposal. The record of each bidder and respective bid shall be open to public inspection.**

**FAILURE TO UPLOAD THE COMPLETE PROPOSAL TO HlePRO SHALL BE GROUNDS FOR REJECTION OF THE BID.**

If there is a conflict between the specification document and the HlePRO solicitation, the specifications shall govern and control, unless otherwise specified.

Bidders must complete all units prices and amounts. Failure to do so may be grounds for rejection of bid

9 If the bid price for any proposal item having a maximum allowable bid  
10 indicated therefore in any of the contract documents is in excess of such a  
11 maximum amount, the bid price for such proposal item shall be adjusted to reflect  
12 the limitation thereon. The comparison of bids to determine the successful  
13 bidder and the amount of contract to be awarded shall be determined after such  
14 adjustments are made, and such adjustments shall be binding upon the bidder.
