## SECTION 641 – HYDRO-MULCH SEEDING Make the following amendments to said Section:

(I) Amend Subsection 641.02 Materials by adding the following after line 21:

"Turfgrass seed shall consist of American Buffel Grass (Cenchrus ciliaris var. 'Laredo'). Seeds shall be acquired from a State certified commercial grass seed supplier. Seed shall be hulled and State certified stating analysis of purity in unopened sealed containers, labeled with brand name and percent purity. Labeling shall indicate that the seeds passed a certified germination.

Apply the seeds at the rate of twenty (20) pounds per acre (minimum) and within twelve (12) months of the date of the certified germination test."

(II) Amend **Subsection 641.02 Materials** by adding the following after line 97:

"(E) Gypsum Based Binder. Gypsum based binder shall be a cementitious binder which, when mixed with water and mulch, forms an erosion resistant crust. The gypsum binder shall be processed to be composed of a crushed, dry calcium sulfate hemihydrate (Ca SO<sub>4</sub> ½ H<sub>2</sub>O) having a purity of not less than 88 percent and combined with necessary additives, such as curing agents, retardants, and accelerators. The binder shall be formulated from a naturally occurring (quarried or mined), high purity gypsum source. The Binder shall be non-toxic and non-combustible and applied per manufacturer's specifications.

The processed gypsum based binder plus necessary additives shall be furnished in bags and labeled as to its intended use/application, purity content, dry weight and source of manufacture. Gypsum based binder that has become partially air set, lumpy or caked, shall not be used."

(III) Amend Subsection 641.02(B) Fertilizer by revising the paragraph from line 33 to 36 to read:

"(B) Fertilizer. Proper fertilizer shall be used in hydro-mulch mix, depending on condition of soil. Apply at rates and in amounts consistent with manufacturer's specifications. Contractor shall provide a Soil Analysis Report, if requested by Engineer, and shall use report to determine quantity and ratio of fertilizer for sustained growth of grass. Submit recommendations from a licensed Landscape Architect when deviating from the application rates and amounts above."

48 49	(IV) Amend Subsection 641.03(A) Seeding by replacing the first paragraph
50	from line 100 to 103 to read:

52	"(A) Seeding. Apply seeded mulch within the timeframe in Subsection
53	209.03(B) - Construction Requirements, if temporary stabilization will not
54	be utilized, after completion of slopes or portion of slope when exposed
55	face attains height of 15 feet. Notify Engineer not less than 24 hours
56	ahead of hydro-mulch seeding operation. Do not hydro-mulch until the
57	Engineer inspects and accepts areas for planting.

59	Install hydro-mulch seeding with gypsum based binder in
60	accordance with the manufacturer's installation guidelines."
