


NOTE: The numbers inside the circle indicate weight of sand in 100 lb unit.

NOTES:

- 1. Installation of portable physical barriers shall conform to Manufacturer's recommendations.
- 2. Physical barriers shall be required whenever guardrails have been removed and will not be reinstalled at the end of the work day.

 See General Note No. 20 on Plan Sht. No. 3.
- 3. Physical barriers shall be either portable concrete barriers or portable water—filled barriers. Installation of portable water—filled barriers shall conform to Manufacturer's recommendations as dictated by design speed and field conditions.
- 4. Providing, transporting, placing, maintaining, relocating and removing physical barriers shall be considered incidental to the various items of work. See Section 645, TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES of the Special Provisions.
- 5. Ends of portable barriers shall be protected with Inertial Barriers as shown hereon. Furnishing, installing and maintaining inertial barriers shall be considered incidental to the various contract items.
- 6. Furnishing, installing and maintaining reflector markers (RM-3) over the portable barriers shall be considered incidental to the various contract items.
