

Bids (hard copies) shall be submitted in a sealed envelope, and shall be on the Proposal Form provided on the compact disc furnished by said Department. Bids received after the established due date and time will not be considered.

The project includes reconstructing weakened pavement areas; cold-planing; resurfacing; removing existing pavement markings and traffic signs; removing existing guardrail end treatments; installing new milled rumble strips, pavement markings and traffic signs; installing new guardrail end treatments; cleaning existing culvert and drainage structures; constructing grouted rubble paving and dressing of shoulders. Estimated construction cost is between \$1,000,000 and \$5,000,000.

To be eligible to for award, bidders must possess a valid State of Hawaii General Engineering Contractor's "A" license prior to bidding.

The Hawaii Products Preference pursuant to ACT 175, SLH 2009 is applicable to this project. Persons wishing to certify and qualify a product as a Hawaii Product shall submit a Certification for Hawaii Product Preference (SPO Form 38) to the Department of Transportation Contracts Office no later than 4:30 p.m., fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the bid opening date.
