



TYPICAL SECTION Scale: 1/2" = 1'-0"

GENERAL NOTES

- I. This project begins at milepost 11.81 on Manele Road, approximately 6.01 miles southerly from Kaumalapau Highway, and extends for a distance of 1.36 miles along Manele Road towards Manele tlarbor. Improvement consist of resurfacing the existing roadway with bituminous surface treatment, widening of curves, installing pavement markers, and pavement striping. The length of project is 1.36 miles.
- 2. All chuck holes and large depressions shall be filled and compacted with bituminous material and aggregate prior to resurfacing as directed by the Engineer. Payment shall be incidental to Type 12 Bituminous Surface Treatment.
- 3. The contractor shall keep at least one lane open to public traffic during his working hours and all lanes open to public traffic during his non-working hours.
- 4. The contractor shall clean the highway surface before installing the pavement markers by brooming off and or as directed by the Engineer. Payment shall be incidental to Pavement Markers.
- 5 Smooth riding transitions shall be constructed at the beginning and ending of the project as directed by the Engineer. The Contractor shall also provide smooth riding transitions between all pavement areas used by public traffic during each construction phase and between transitions of construction phases. Payment for making smooth transitions shall be incidental to Type 12 Bituminous Surface Treatment.
- 6. All construction signs shall be left in-place until all construction items are completed.
