

GENERAL NOTES

- The Contractor shall remove and dispose of all existing raised pavement markers prior to the pavement striping. This work shall be considered incidental to the various pavement marking items and will not be paid for separately.
- 2. Layout of pavement markings and striping shall be done by the Contractor and approved by the Engineer prior to any installation work.
- 3. Existing pavement markings not incorporated in the final traffic pattern shall be removed as directed by the Engineer. Costs shall be incidental to the various pavement marking items.
- 4. Raised pavement markers shall not be installed within crosswalks.
- 5. Final locations of all Stop Lines shall be approved by the Engineer prior to installation.
- 6. All pavement striping shall be as noted on the legend or plans.
- 7. The Contractor shall erect and maintain at the beginning and end of the project advance construction warning signs placed as indicated on the plans or as directed by the Engineer for the duration of the highway project. These Signs shall be placed in addition to the required traffic control signs called for in Section 645 - Traffic Control. The advance construction warning signs shall be new and become the property of the State. The Contractor shall remove, clean, and deliver the signs and posts to the Lanai Baseyard




PERMANENT CONSTRUCTION SIGN LAYOUT DETAIL
