

 - To stabilize and protect the slopes and roadway from sinking
- Project Scope and Special Conditions were discussed
 - Project consists of asphalt road repairs and drainage improvements
 - Contractors were notified of the present degrading conditions on the roadway
- Contractor presented the following questions
 - Will the work affect traffic in the area?
 - Yes, a traffic control plan was provided in the plans and must be implemented.
 - Will there be scarifying of the existing asphalt road?
 - Yes, plans call for milling 3-3/4" of asphalt.
 - Will there be landscaping work?
 - Yes, erosion control plans call for hydromulch with rye grass.
