- 1. Remove existing Street Name/Stop signs and posts. Replace with new Street Name/Stop signs and posts. Return all Street Name signs to the Traffic Signs and Marking Section, County's Molokai Baseyard.
- 2. All signs shall be high intensity reflective and shall conform with State Standard Plans TE-01 through TE-04.
- 3. Refer to DPW STandard Detail TE-14 for design of Standard Street Name sign with Blocking Numbering.
- 4. Refer to DPW Standard Detail TE-11 for installation of Street Name sign on Stop sign.

- 2. Letter Size:
- a. When letters are all uppercase, use series "E" unless otherwise noted.
- b. When initial uppercase letter is used in conjunction with lower case letters, use series "E" (M) for uppercase letter.
- 3. Interstate Route Marker Symbols shall conform to details shown on the plans and as specified in the MUTCD.
- 4. All signs shall conform to Section 621 of the Special Provisions and the latest editions and amendments of the following FHWA publications:
- a. "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways" MUTCD)
- b. "Standard Highway Signs"
- c. "Standard Alphabets for Highway Signs"
- 5. Borders, messages, arrows, symbols and shield conform to details as shown on the plans and as specified in the MUTCD.
- 6. Signs messages shall be as indicated on the plans.
- 7. All panels shall be reflectorized in accordance with Section 712.20 of the Standard Specifications. Minimum width of panels shall be 2 feet. Abutting edges of panels shall be in only one direction if vertical abutting edges are used, no horizontal abutting edges shall be allowed and vice versa.
- 8. Contractor shall submit all sign splicing details to the Engineer for approval. All backing for signs 4 feet by 6 feet or less shall be of one sheet.
- 9. All signs shall be provided w/frame stiffeners in accordance with TE-03 of the Standard Plans.
- 10. Destination signs shall be installed with flanged channel posts (4.00 Lbs./Ft.), 3-post installation, unless shown otherwise on the plans.
