

NOTES:

- 1. New Riser Neck shall be constructed to meet new resurfacing finish grade. Construction details, maximum clearance, dimensions and materials shall be in accordance with Maui Electric Co. Standard Drawing No. 18848.
- 2. Removing and disposing of the existing Riser Neck shall not be paid for separately, but shall be considered incidental to adjusting the electric handhole.
- 3. If the work cannot be completed at the end of the work day, the Contractor shall provide a non-skid steel plate cover for partially completed handhole. This work shall be considered incidental to adjusting the electric handhole.
- 4. The Contractor shall notify MECO a minimum of 72 hours prior to commencing work.
