GENERAL NOTES:

- 1. The Scope of Work for this project consists of improvements to Hana Highway at MP 16. Improvements consist of stabilizing the steep mauka slope with a wire mesh and deep soil nail anchors.
- 2. The Contractor's attention is directed to the following Sections of the Standard Specifications and Special Provisions: Subsection 104.11 - Utilities and Services Section 107 - Legal Relations and Responsibility to Public; and Section 645 - Work Zone Traffic Control.
- 3. At the end of each day's work, the Contractor shall remove all equipment and other obstructions to permit free and safe passage of public traffic.
- 4. The existence and location of underground utilities, manholes, monuments and structures as shown on the plans are from the latest available data but the accuracy is not guaranteed. The encountering of other obstacles during the course of work is possible. The Contractor shall be held liable for any damages incurred to the existing facilities and/or improvements as a result of his operations.
- 5. Dressing of shoulders shall consist of clearing, grubbing, grading, reshaping, and compacting the unpaved shoulders with suitable material as shown on the plans and/or as directed by the Engineer. This work shall be considered incidental to the various contract items.
- 6. Existing drainage system will be functional at all times during construction. The Contractor is to furnish materials, equipment, labor, tools and incidentals necessary to maintain flow. This work shall be considered incidental to various contract items.
- 7. Earth swales shall be graded to drain. This work shall be considered incidental to the various contract items.
- 8. The Contractor shall clean and remove any accumulation of aggregates along the roadside within 15 feet of the edge of pavement. This work shall be considered incidental to the various contract items.
- 9. All necessary permits shall be obtained by the Contractor at his own cost.
- 10. The Contractor shall comply with the State of Hawaii's Occupational Safety and Health Law (DOSH).
- 11. All lanes shall be opened to traffic during the morning peak hours from 6:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m., during the afternoon peak hours from 3:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. and off work hours or as directed by the Engineer. As a minimum, one lane of highway shall remain open during work hours.
- 12. In the event that historical resources, including human skeletal remains, cultural materials, lava tubes, and lava blisters/bubbles are discovered during construction activities, the contractor shall cease work in the immediate vicinity of the find, protect it from additional disturbances, and call the State Historical Preservation Division, Maui Island Section at (808) 243-1285.
