a. Project Overview

The project includes milled rumble strips, signage, striping and pavement markers and guardrail replacement.

- 3. Deadline for RFIs December 13, 2017
 - a. Addendum will be issued to address any RFIs including questions asked during the pre-bid meeting.
- 4. Construction Concerns
 - a. Section 7 Requirements
 - As per notes on the plans:

- Consideration for water birds, Hawaiian Stilt and Nene, may be present in the vicinity of the proposed project site. If a nest is discovered, the Contractor shall notify the Department of Forestry and Wildlife (DOFAW). If a bird is present, activities within 100-feet of the bird shall cease and the bird shall not be approached. Work may continue after the bird leaves on its own accord.
- Woody plants greater than 15-feet tall shall not be disturbed, removed or trimmed during the Hawaiian Hoary Bat birthing and pup rearing season (June 1 through September 15). Time site clearing to avoid disturbance to breeding Hawaiian Hoary Bats.
- Removal of plants greater than 1 meter in height shall be conducted during the dry season (May through September). Prior to removing plants with tree tobacco that are taller than one meter in height or disturbing the ground around or within several meters of these plants, the Contractor shall check thoroughly for the presence of Blackburn's Sphinx Moth Eggs and larvae. If found, the Contractor shall contact DOFAW.
- If lighting of the work area is required, all lights shall be shielded (minimum light spill towards the sky) and directed downwards to the maximum extent practicable.
- ii. No night work or cutting of trees is anticipated, however, Contractor should be aware of requirements.

- Arborist services for guardrail installation to be determined by the engineer in the field (DOT). Item pertains to guardrail installation near existing tree in front of Olowalu Store. Tree is not on the list of majestic trees.
- Contractor is responsible for retaining Arborist. Requirements are provided in the special provisions.

5. Question & Answer Forum

Question 1: Contractor requested clarification on use of BMPs along the shoulder of pavement during construction of milled rumble strips.

Answer 1: BMPs to protect existing drainage culverts are required at all times during construction. BMPs along pavement edges for active construction of milled rumble strips are to be used as necessary to protect from runoff during construction.

Question 2: Contractor requested clarification on DBE requirements for the project.

Answer 2: There is no DBE goal specified for this project.

Question 3: Bid Item Nos. 631.0400 & 631.0500 – Miscellaneous Signs These signs are shown on the drawings without sizes or dimensions. Please provide sizes.

Answer 3: Sign dimensions and sizes are provided on the revised plans.

Question 4: There are Bike Route (D-11) signs on the drawings. Are these signs included in Bid Item No. 631.0400. If not, is there a bid item no. for these? Please verify.

Answer 4: The bike route signs are included under Bid Item No. 631.0400.

Question 5: There are Type Route Marker Assembly (M3-4, etc.) on the drawings. Are these signs included in Bid Item No. 634.0400? If not, is there a bid item no. for these? Please verify.

Answer 5: The type route marker assemblies are included under Bid Item No. 631.0400.
