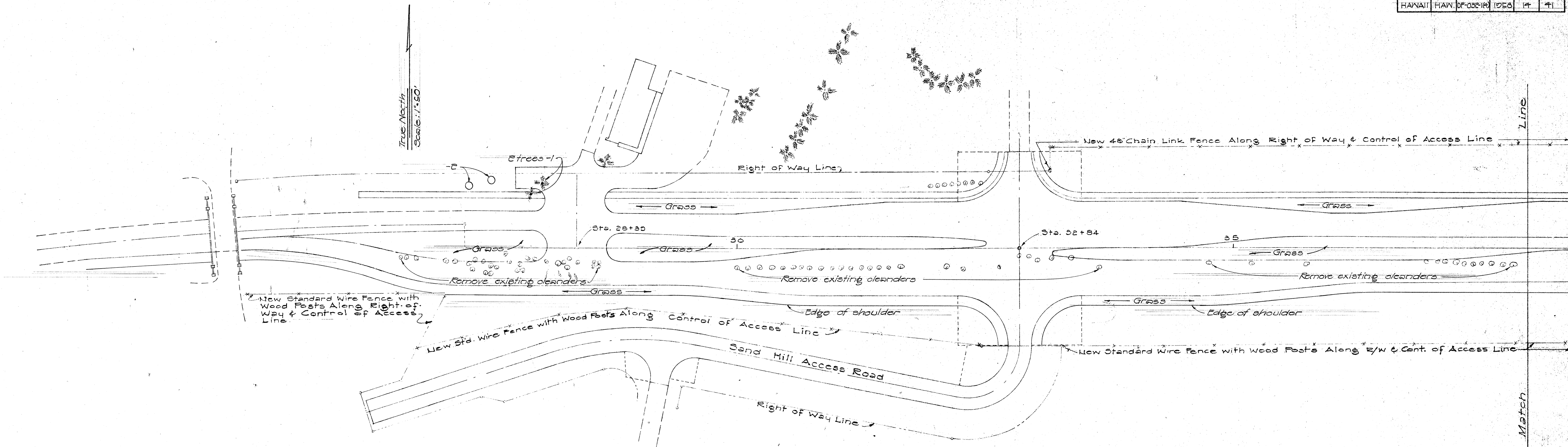
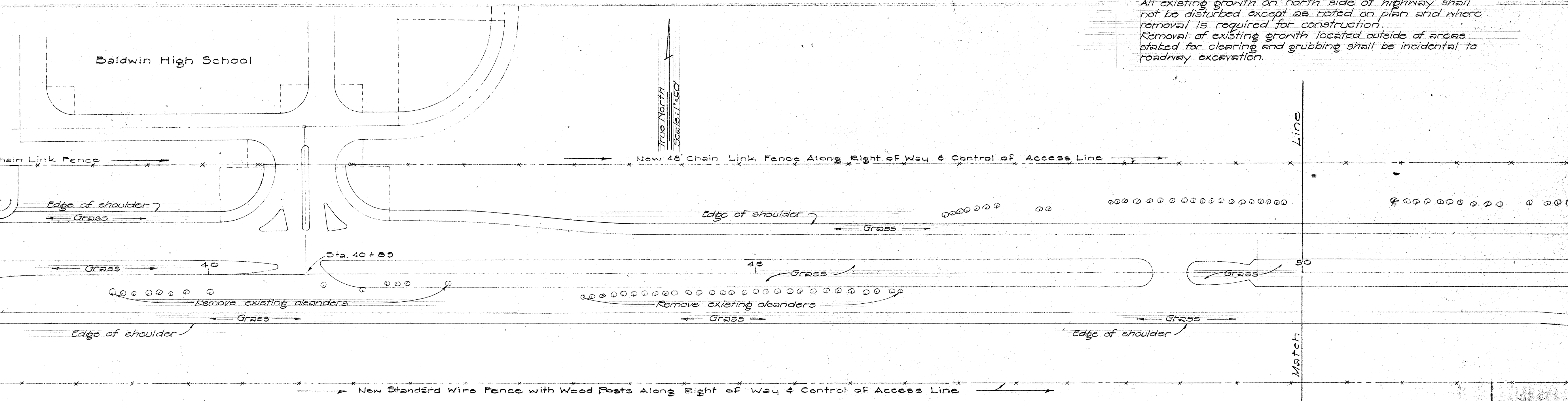




**GENERAL NOTES:**  
 All shoulders and medial strip shall be planted to Bermuda grass (*Cynodon Dactylon*). Leave existing growth on south side of highway outside of shoulder areas, except where removal is required for construction. All existing growth on north side of highway shall not be disturbed except as noted on plan and where removal is required for construction. Removal of existing growth located outside of areas slated for clearing and grubbing shall be incidental to roadway excavation.

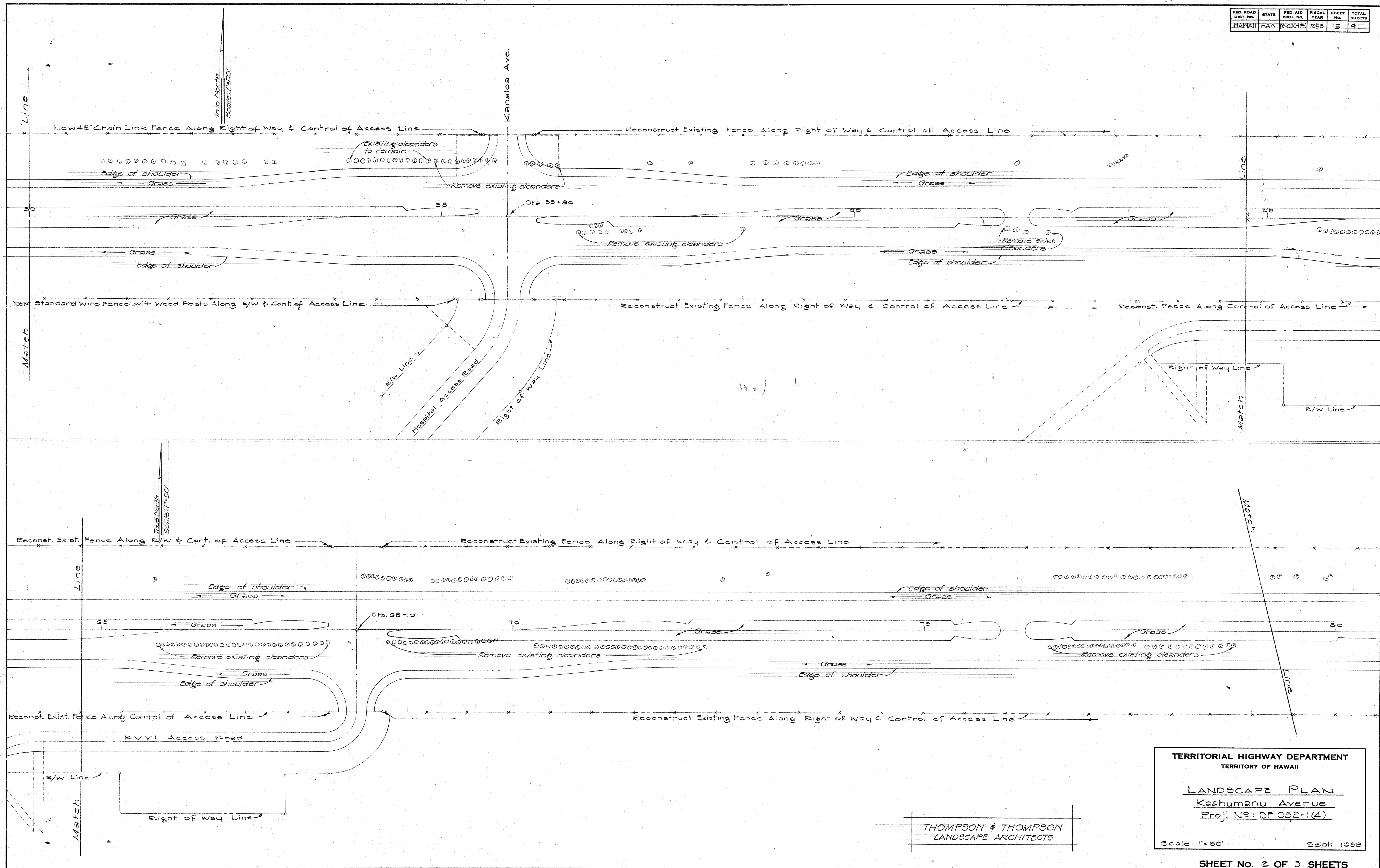

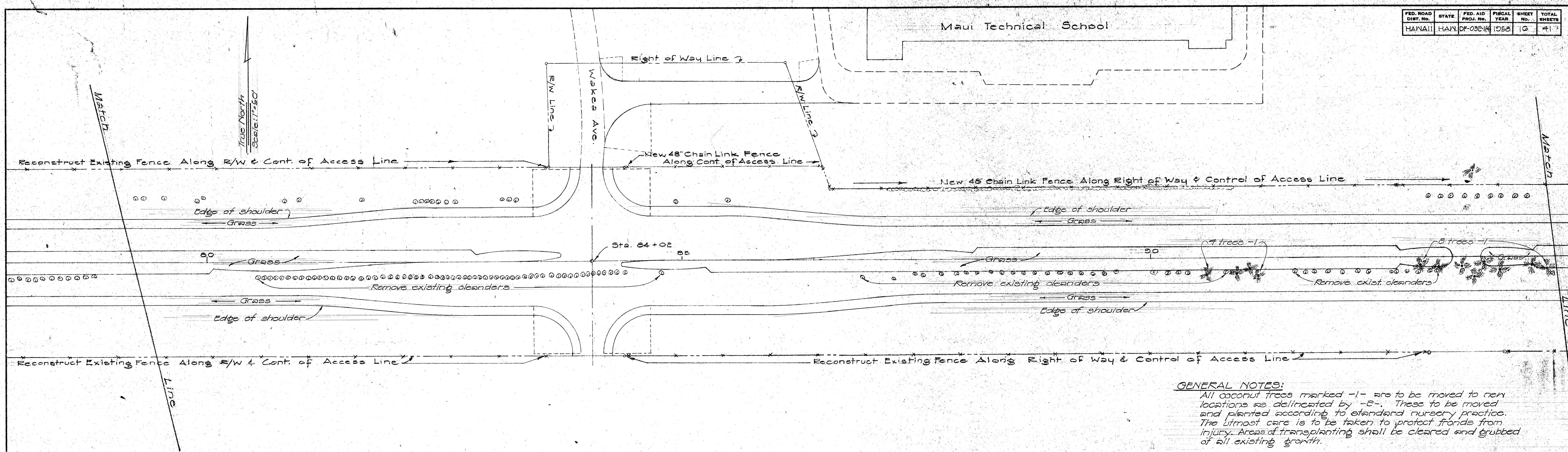
LANDSCAPE PLAN

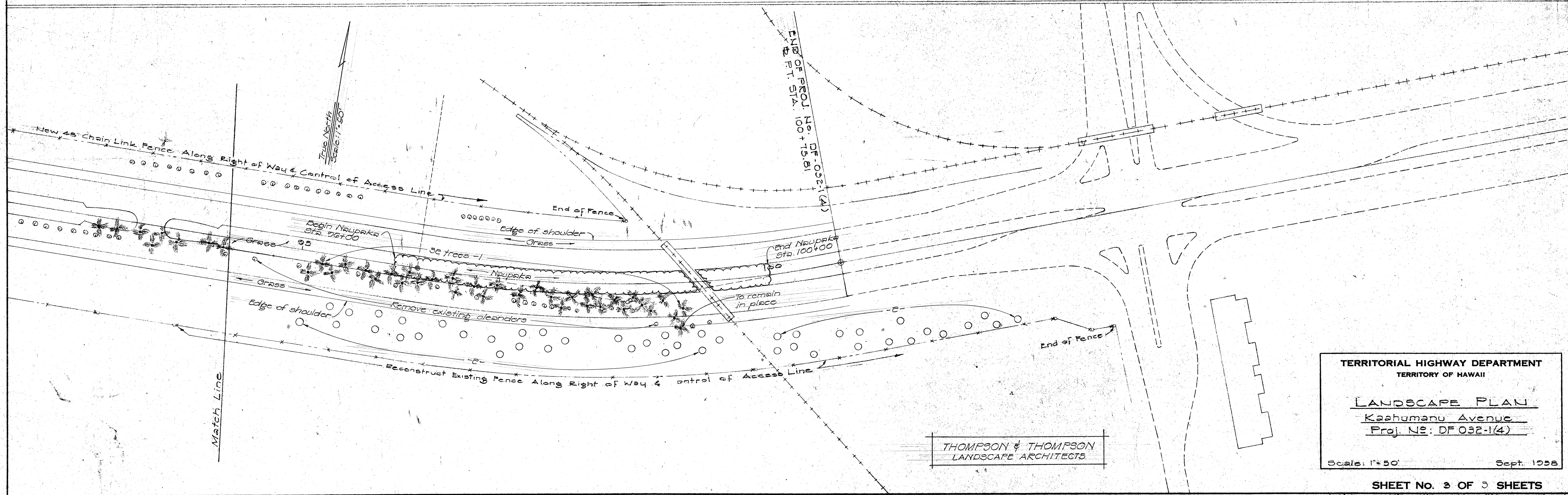
