 - (6) All existing street monuments shall be raised, as shown on plan, after paving. This item of work shall be considered incidental to A.C. Pavement and no separate payment shall be made therefor.
 - (7) Before paving, the contractor shall reference all existing manholes in a manner satisfactory to the Engineer. This shall be considered incidental to A.C. Pavement and no separate payment shall be made therefor.
 - (8) Cross walks, stop bars, and all other painted stripes shall be done by others.
 - (9) Pavement markers shall be furnished and installed by others. For reference see Standard Detail on Raised Pavement Markers.
 - (10) Shoulders to be graded and compacted to provide the proper cross slope with the new pavement. Payment incidental to A.C. Pavement.
