

COUNTY OF MAUI CONSTRUCTION NOTES

PUBLIC WORKS

- 1. The Contractor shall obtain a "Grading Permit" four (4) weeks prior to commencement of any clearing and grubbing from the Land Use and Codes Division of the Department of Public Works, County of Maui. A satisfactory dust and erosion control plan and/or outline shall be submitted by the Contractor.
- 2. The Director of Public Works or the Director of Water Supply may stop construction should any work be found contrary to the approved construction plan or be detrimental to the public interest.
- 3. Bench Marks shall be established and certified by a registered surveyor and submitted to the Division of Land Use and Codes.

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

- 1. The Contractor shall keep the project area and surrounding areas free from dust nuisance, all in accordance with the Air Pollution Control Standards and Regulations of the State Department of Health. All costs shall be borne by the Contractor.
- 2. All grading operations shall be performed in conformance with the applicable provisions of the Water Pollution Control and Water Quality Standards of the Public Health Regulations of the State Department of Health and the County Grading Ordinance.
- 3. Construction debris and wastes shall be deposited at appropriate sites. The Contractor shall inform the Engineer of the location of disposal sites. The disposal site must also fulfill the requirements of the grading ordinance.
- 4. The Contractor shall not demolish or clear any structure, site, or vacant lot without first ascertaining the presence or absence of rodents which may endanger the public health by dispersal from such premises. Should such inspection reveal the presence of such rodents, the Contractor shall eradicate such rodents before demolishing or clearing said structure, site, or vacant lot.

DUST CONTROL

Following measures shall be taken to control erosion during the site development period:

- 1. Retain existing ground cover until latest date to complete construction.
- 2. Station water truck on site during construction period to provide for immediate sprinkling, as needed, in active construction zones (weekends and holidays included).
- 3. Graded areas shall be thoroughly watered after construction activity has ceased for the day and on weekends.

EXISTING UTILITIES

- 1. The location, depth and type of the various existing utility lines shown on the construction plans were determined on the basis of the best information available. The Contractor shall verify exact location, depth and type prior to commencement of work.
- 2. Contractor shall notify the Engineer of any discrepancies between the existing utilities as shown on the construction

plans and in ground, and not proceed with any further work until written notification is received from the Engineer.

- 3. All existing utilities whether or not shown on plans, if damaged during construction by the the Contractor, shall be repaired at his expense.

COUNTY OF MAUI WATER NOTES

- 1. The Contractor shall notify the Department of Water Supply in writing one week prior to commencement of work.
- 2. The exact depth and location of existing waterlines, service laterals and other facilities are not known. It shall be the Contractor's responsibility to locate same, prior to trenching of new waterline. The cost of lowering, relocating, or adjusting existing waterline service laterals (unless otherwise noted) and other utilities shall be considered incidental to the cost of the new waterline and will not be paid for separately. Facilities damage by the Contractor's operation shall be repaired immediately by the Contractor at his expense.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project is located in the vicinity of the intersection of Hana Highway and Nalu Place. Improvements consist of constructing a 24-inch reinforced concrete pipe culvert, concrete drop intakes and storm drain manholes.
