


GENERAL NOTES

- 1. Improvements consist of resurfacing with asphalt concrete, constructing paved shoulders, adjusting manhole frames and covers and installing pavement markings.
- 2. Prior to placing leveling course or resurfacing, the existing surface shall be cleaned as described in Section 310 of the Standard Specifications and as amended. Payment shall be considered incidental to Item No. 401.0500, Asphalt Concrete Pavement, Mix No. \nabla.
- 3. The Contractor's attention is directed to Subsection 107.21- Contractor's Responsibility for Utility Property and Service of the Special Provisions for the utility company notes which pertain to this project.
- 4. At the end of each day's work, the Contractor shall remove all equipment and other obstructions to permit free and safe passage of public traffic.
- 5. The existence and locations of manholes, monuments and underground utilities and structures as shown on the plans are based upon records of varying degrees of accuracy and completeness and, as such, the encountering of other obstructions is not guaranteed against. The Contractor shall be liable for any damage to the existing facilities, whether or not said facilities are shown on the plans.
- 6. The Contractor shall remove and dispose of all existing raised pavement markers prior to the overlaying of Asphalt Concrete. This work shall be considered incidental to Asphalt Concrete Pavement, Mix No. \nabla and will not be paid for seperately.
- 7. All holes, depressions and wheel ruts shall be filled and compacted with Asphalt Concrete Pavement, $Mix\ No.\ V$ prior to resurfacing. This work will be paid for under Asphalt Concrete Pavement, $Mix\ No\ V$.
- 8. Shoulder dressing shall consist of clearing and grubbing, backfilling, grading and reshaping and compacting with suitable excavated material, as directed by the Engineer. This work shall be considered incidental to the various contract items.
- 9. Smooth riding connections shall be constructed at all limits of resurfacing, including the beginning and end of project, connecting approaches, side streets and driveways as shown on the plans and/or as directed by the Engineer.




TYPICAL SECTION

TYPICAL SIDEROAD, DRIVEWAY CONNECTION


