The receiving of SEALED BIDS Hana Highway Rockfall Mitigation MP12, Project No. 36C-01-10 will begin as advertised on in HlePRO. Bidders are to register and submit bids through HlePRO only. See the following HlePRO link for important information on registering: <https://hiepro.ehawaii.gov/welcome.html>.

Deadline to submit bids is - Thursday, June 4, 2020 at 2:00 p.m. Hawaii Standard Time (HST). Bids received after said due date and time shall not be considered.

The scope of work consists of construction of slope stabilization mauka of Hana Highway at three locations, consisting of erosion control matting and high strength wire mesh with soil nails; and construction of slope stabilization makai of Hana Highway at one location. The estimated cost of construction is between \$5,000,000 and \$10,000,000.

To be eligible for award, bidders must possess a valid State of Hawaii General Engineering "A" license at the time of bidding.

The Hawaii Products Preference pursuant to Section 103D-1002, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), is applicable to this project. Persons wishing to certify and qualify a product as a Hawaii Product shall submit a Certification for Hawaii Product Preference (SPO) Form 38) to the DOT Contracts office no later than 4:30 P.M., fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the bid opening date. Late submittals for this project will not be reviewed by the DOT. A separate SPO-Form 38 shall be completed and submitted for each product. Forms are available at <http://spo.hawaii.gov/all-forms/>.

A 5% bid adjustment for bidders that are parties to apprenticeship agreements pursuant to Section 103-55.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), is applicable to this project.

Compliance with Act 192, SLH 2011 is a requirement for this project whereby a minimum of 80% of the bidder's work force on this project **must** consist of Hawaii residents.

A pre-bid conference is scheduled for May 14, 2020 at 2:00 p.m. HST via teleconference. All prospective bidders or their representatives (employees) are encouraged to attend, but attendance is not mandatory. Call-in information for the pre-bid conference is as follows:

ALL requests for information (RFI) shall be received in writing via HiePRO by the stated deadline. Questions received after the deadline will not be addressed. Verbal requests for information will not receive a response. Anything said at the conference is for clarification purposes and any changes to the bid documents will be made by addendum and posted in HiePRO.

Any protest of this solicitation shall be submitted in writing to the Director of Transportation, in accordance with §103D-701, HRS and §3-126, HAR.

Campaign contributions by State and County Contractors. Contractors are hereby notified of the applicability of Section 11-355, HRS, which states that campaign contributions are prohibited from specified State or county government contractors during the term of the contract if the contractors are paid with funds appropriated by a legislative body.
