This project includes shoulder widening; reconstructing weakened pavement areas; resurfacing existing pavement; cold planning; adjusting monuments, guardrails posts, manhole frame and covers; striping and installing signage and pavement markers; and cleaning existing culverts. Estimated construction cost is between \$5 million and \$10 million.

To be eligible for award, bidders must possess a valid State of Hawaii General Engineering Contactor's "A" license, at the time of bidding.

In accordance with Section 3-124-4, Hawaii Administrative Rules, this project is subject to Hawaii Product Preference.
