

Install 6" wide solid white paint stripe at approach end of Shoulder Rumble Strip as shown. Payment of stripe shall not be paid for separately but shall be considered incidental to Contract Item

NOTES:

(DIVIDED HIGHWAY/MEDIAN SHOULDER)

- 1. Bicycle Friendly shoulder milled rumble strip shall not be installed where shoulder serves a a part time shoulder lane.
- **2. Bicyle Friendly shoulder milled rumble strip should not be used unless 4 feet of clear shoulder width for bicycle use is available between the rumble strips and the outer edge of the paved shoulder.
- * 3. Length of rumble strip may be reduced from 12" to 6" minimum where needed to meet clearance. Designer is required to coordinate with HWY-T for shoulder milled rumble strip design that is less than 12" in length.
- 4. Do not place Type "C" markers within 2 feet of the 13 feet Rumble Strip opening.
- 5. For median shoulders, install continuous milled shoulder rumble strip.
- 6. Where at-grade bridges are present, rumble strip shall end/begin 20 L.F. beyond the existing bridge deck joints/concrete approach slab.
- 7. The construction of the Shoulder Rumble Strip shall be paid for under Item No. 615.0400 - 12-inch Milled Rumble Strip, Bicycle Friendly Shoulder.
- 8. The milling apparatus will not be paid for separately and shall be considered incidental to the various Milled Rumble Strip items.







- 1. Continuous shoulder milled rumble strip shall not be installed where shoulder serves as a part time shoulder lane.
- * 2. Length of rumble strip may be reduced from 12" to 6" minimum where needed to meet clearance. Designer is required to coordinate with HWY-T for milled shoulder rumble strip design that is less than 12" in length.
- 3. Continuous shoulder milled rumble strips should not be installed where paved shoulder is less than 2 feet.
- 4. Where at-grade bridges are present, rumble strip shall end/begin 20 L.F. beyond the existing bridge deck joints/concrete approach slab.
- 5. The construction of the Shoulder Rumble Strip shall be paid for under Item No. 615.0500 - 12-inch Milled Rumble Strip, Continuous Shoulder.
- 6. The milling apparatus will not be paid for separately and shall be considered incidental to the various Milled Rumble Strip items.
