


TYPICAL SECTION

- I. Prior to placing leveling course or resurfacing, the existing surface shall be cleaned as described in Section 310 of The Standard Specifications. Payment shall be considered incidental to Item No. 401.0500, A.C. Pavement Mix No. \(\mathbb{\sigma}\).
- 2. All holes, cracks and large depressions shall be filled, leveled and compacted with A.C. Pavement Mix No. I prior to resurfacing as directed by the Engineer. Payment shall be made under Item No. 401.0500, A.C. Pavement Mix No. I.
- 3. In general, the total A.C. pavement overlay thickness shall be 1/2 inches unless otherwise directed by the Engineer.
- 4. Smooth riding connections shall be constructed at the beginning and the end of the project, at all connecting approaches, and at extra widening as directed by the Engineer. Payment for this work shall be made under Item No. 401.0500, A.C. Pavement Mix No. Y
- 5. The Contractor shall replace the stop lines or any other pavement markings that are covered by his paving operations of the adjacent sideroads. Payment shall be made under Item No. 629.1011; Pavement Striping (Paint).
- 6. The Contractor shall construct tapers at driveways and sideroads as shown on the plans, unless otherwise directed by the Engineer. Payment for this work shall be made under Item No. 401.0500, A.C. Pavement Mix V
- 1. The Contractor shall remove all existing raised pavement markers on areas to be resurfaced. This work shall be considered incidental to Item No. 401.0500, A.C. Pavement Mix No. Y.
- 8. The Contractor shall reference all existing pavement markings prior to resurfacing. Final placement of the new pavement markings shall be as approved by the Engineer. Payment for this work shall be considered incidental to new pavement markers and striping.
- 9. Preparation of shoulder areas after resurfacing shall be done by State Forces.
- 10. The Contractor shall notify the State, in writing, two weeks prior to starting paving operations.
- 11. The Contractor's attention is directed to Sub-Sections 102.05-Examination of Plans, Specifications, Special Provisions, Site of Work, etc. and 104.04,-Maintenance of Traffic and 107.13-Public Convenience and Safety and Section 645-Traffic Control of the Standard Specifications and Special Provisions.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project begins at milepost 33.68 on Hana Highway in the vicinity of the Civic Center and extends easterly for 0.75 mile, then northerly on Keawa Place for 0.22 mile. The length of project is 0.97 mile.

Improvements consist of resurfacing and installing traffic signs, reflector

markers and pavement markings.
