### **INFORMATION ITEMS:**

1. Contractor asked about the bid item regarding field office trailer.

Response: There is no location for an office trailer.

2. Contractor asked if a full geotechnical report can be provided. They pointed out that only borings are included in the bid docs.

Response: Contact Maui District office for a copy of the Geotechnical report.

3. Contractor asked about a water source in the area.

Response: The Keanae Baseyard can be used but contractor to secure their own method of drawing water.

4. Contractor asked when is the last day to submit Questions?

Response: DOT will allow questions till March 1st. After that, no questions will be answered.

5. Contractor asked when the proposed NTP will be.

Response: DOT said typically 180 days after award.

Contractor asked where the temporary barrier rails be dropped off after project.

Response: DOT instructed to drop off rails at either the Keanae or Kahului Baseyard.

Contractor asked for a contact email address.

Response: DOT provided Alan Matsuda's email, alan.m.matsuda@hawaii.gov.

Contractor asked whether temporary traffic signals (as stated in the specs) or police

officers (as stated in the plans) were to be used.

Response: DOT will allow either option.

- 9. Contractor asked if a they can run one lane permanent throughout the project duration. Response: DOT informed that they have allowed it for past projects in the area and will allow it here, subject to approval.
- 10. Contractor questioned about test panels for shotcrete. Explained that specs call for 3 reinforced panels and 3 unreinforced panels but also a test panel for sculpting. Can 1 of the 6 test panels be considered the sculpting test panel, so 6 panels total or 7? Response: No, 7 panels are required.
- Contractor asked about working hours.
   Response: Work hours will be typical, 7:00-3:30. If permanent lane closure allowed, work hours will be discussed with State.
