2. Purpose of the meeting was to discuss the scope of the project and also listen to and answer any questions or concerns that the contractors may have regarding the bid documents.

B. Project Scope and Special Conditions

Scope of project includes overlaying 1½ " of A.C. on existing pavement, reconstruction of weakened pavement areas, cold planing, installation of pavement markings, installation of reflector markers, utility adjustments and cleaning of culverts.

C. Questions/Concerns

- Contractors questioned whether the quantity of asphalt as estimated in the Proposal was correct. ***State will verify quantity and adjust it accordingly.***
- Contractor noticed that the item numbers for pavement striping and pavement parking as shown in the proposal are the same numbers. ***State will change the item numbers that corresponds with the pavement markers.***

- Contractor pointed out that in General Notes no. 11, it states that payment for cold planing is incidental to HMA pavement. ***Because there is a separate item for cold planing, State will remove the last sentence of the note which reads, "Payment for this work shall be considered incidental to Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Pavement."***
- Contractors questioned why item no. 696.6200 – Maintenance of Trailers was included in the Proposal since there's no trailer in the vicinity of the project. **Item no. to remain but will cover the maintenance of the trailer in Kula.**
