The bidder is directed to Subsection 105.16 – Subcontracts.

The bidder's attention is directed to Sections 696 – Maintenance of trailers and 699 - Mobilization for the limitation of the amount bidders are allowed to bid.

If the bid price for any proposal item having a maximum allowable bid indicated therefore in any of the contract documents is in excess of such a maximum amount, the bid price for such proposal item shall be adjusted to reflect the limitation thereon.
