The Hawaii Department of Transportation, Highways Division, is soliciting proposals for the design, procurement, installation, and testing of a new video wall system for their Traffic Operations Center (TOC), located at the H-3 Halawa portal building of the H-3 Trans-Koolau tunnels. Sealed Proposals will be received at the Contracts Office, Department of Transportation, 869 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813, until 2:00 p.m., Hawaii Standard Time (HST), on December 15, 2011

To be eligible for award, Offerors must possess a valid State of Hawaii Specialty Contractor's "C-13" or "C-15" license, prior to award of the contract.

A pre-proposal conference will be held on November 2, 2011 at 9:00 AM in the Conference Room at the H-3 TOC located at the H-3 Halawa portal building. All prospective Offerors are encouraged to attend but attendance is not mandatory. A site visit to allow potential Offerors a walk-through of the existing TOC and Equipment Room will follow the conference. Limited facilities are available for the conference and site visit. Representation will be limited to two (2) individuals per Offeror team. Due to security at the facility, Offerors interested in attending should contact Mr. Benson Chow, Project Manager, by phone at (808) 692-7676 or by facsimile at (808) 692-7690 at least seven (7) days prior to the conference to identify the individuals expected to attend.

Persons needing special accommodations at the pre-proposal conference due to a disability may contact Mr. Benson Chow as shown above.

Questions posed and discussed at the pre-proposal conference and walk-through will be documented as necessary in a follow up addendum which will be distributed to the attendees by the Issuing Office. This addendum will serve as the official record of the walk through and discussion.

Persons, firms or entities that are interested in being considered for providing the services described in this announcement and who have the qualifications and the resources to do so may obtain specifications for the proposal at the above office. Inquiries in regards to obtaining the specifications may also be made by calling (808) 587-2130.

Any person, firm, or other entity that submits a proposal must, at the time of contract execution, provide the State of Hawaii with a statement or certificate from the Hawaii State Director of Taxation and the Internal Revenue Service to the effect that all delinquent taxes, interest, and penalties levied or accrued against said person, firm, or corporation have been paid, and any other evidence requested by and acceptable to the contracting officer to demonstrate that the Offeror is not in default on any obligation due to the State of Hawaii, any of its political subdivisions, or the Internal Revenue Service.


