I. <u>INTRODUCTION</u>

II. <u>IMPORTANT ITEMS</u>

- 1. This meeting is to clarify general questions only. If there is a conflict between what was stated in this meeting and the bid documents, the bid documents shall govern. Any significant changes will be issued through an addendum. A copy of the meeting minutes will be issued to all attendees.
- 2. Deadline for questions is 9:00 a.m. HST on May 24, 2023. Questions and responses will be published on May 26, 2023.

All questions must be submitted via HIePRO.

3. Proposals due on June 7, 2023, at 2:00 p.m. HST.

- 4. The scope of work consists of repairing substructure spalls and epoxy coating work at Piers 16 and 17 at Honolulu Harbor, Oahu, Hawaii.
- 5. The estimated cost is \$1,600,000 to \$1,700,000.
- 6. Key Information
 - a. Bidders must possess a valid State of Hawaii General Engineering Contractor's "A" license at the time of bidding.
 - b. Completion time is 300 calendar days.

III. GENERAL DISCUSSIONS

1. Question: Is the fecal-contaminated water still a concern?

Response: Yes, bidders shall assume the fecal-contaminated water may be present and shall take appropriate actions. Additional information can be found in Section 10.5 of the Specifications.

2. Question: Is there a coal tar coating present?

Response: Yes, the underside of Pier 16 is coated with a coal tar epoxy. See Specifications for additional information and abatement.

3. Question: Since the piers are narrow, will access on the topside need to be maintained?

Response: Yes, per Section 15.1.A of the Specifications, work shall be performed in phases to always maintain a three-foot walkway at Pier 16 and a travel way at Pier 17. Contractor shall be responsible for providing a barricade restricting access over the repair areas.
