

PROJECT NUMBER: HWY-OM-2011-37

Pre-Bid Conference began at 10:00 AM and was opened by stating it is an open-ended project and that this conference would answer any questions related to the project.

1. Question: Will traffic control and temporary markings be incidental?

 Response: Yes, these items are incidental to Section 401 – Hot Mix Asphalt Pavement, except for the Electronic Message Board which has its own line item.
2. Question: Will HDOT issue work orders for an entire route or break it up on an as-needed basis?

 Response: Work orders will specify the scope of work. The scope could be for specific sections only or it could be for an entire route.
3. Question: Do we need to provide site-specific traffic control plans?

 Response: The Field Engineer may require site-specific traffic control plans.
4. Question: Are public notices for each work order or work site required? Do we need to notify every homeowner/business owner adjacent to the work site?

 Response: Public notices are not required for each work order. The Contractor must notify every homeowner/business owner adjacent to the work site.
5. Question: Who is the Field Engineer?

 Response: Ryan Nakata is the Highways Division Field Engineer.
6. Question: Will staging areas be provided?

 Response: You can request these areas through the Field Engineer.

7. Question: Do we need permits, such as for staging and performing work within the State right-of-way, for each work site?
- Response: Yes. Obtain permits from the Oahu District Office permits counter.
8. Question: What does "respond within 48 hours notice" mean?
- Response: It means to acknowledge the work request to the Highways Division Field Engineer.
9. Question: Will the permanent striping be done under another contract?
- Response: Yes.
10. Question: Does the Prime Contractor Supervisor have to remain on-site with the Subcontractor?
- Response: The Prime Contractor is not required to be on-site with its subcontractors, but will be responsible for all actions by its subcontractors.
11. Question: Is it possible to have a combination of work items in one work order?
- Response: Yes.
12. Question: Do you know where the targeted areas of work will be?
- Response: No, they are island-wide.
13. Question: Will there be short-supply provisions?
- Response: No.
14. Question: Is price escalation allowed in the 2nd and 3rd years?
- Response: No, the 2nd and 3rd years have the same pricing as the 1st year of the contract.
