1. Question: In the Section 104 - Scope of Work, what does "respond" mean (line 13)?

Response: In this context, respond means to acknowledge the request to the Highways

Division Field Engineer.

2. Question: Will there be any electrical work? Will we need to have an electrical contractor

as a subconsultant?

Response: There will be no electrical work.

3. Question: Are destination signs included in this contract?

Response: Yes, see Section 110-1a.

4. Question: How will we know if a sign is older than 10 years old?

Response: You can ask the Highways Division Field Engineer.

5. Question: Do we need either a Type A license or a C-14 license?

Response: Yes.

6. Question: Will painting be needed? And if so, will a painting subcontractor be needed?

Response: There will be no painting work.

7. Question: What is a slip base post? Is it two flanges bolted at the base?

Response: Generally, yes.

Will Traffic Control be included? Question: 8. Yes, traffic control is included in the various contract items of Section 630, 631 Response: and 632. Will the foundations need to be replaced when the sign post is damaged? Question: 9. Response: Yes. Will there be storage space available for the signs and is it at no cost to the 10. Question: contractor? If available, the State may be able to provide storage space, but this is not Response: guaranteed. Response: If the existing posts have RM-3 reflectors, then they shall be replaced. The cost

20. Question: Will the attaching hardware to mount new expressway/destination signs be

required? There is no call out for that in the provisions. Do we use new

hardware or the existing hardware?

Response: Yes, new hardware is required and the cost is incidental to the

expressway/destination sign.

21. Question: Will double strapping of signs attached to existing poles be required? If so,

which signs and who is to determine, for example the "windy locations."

Response: All signs replaced on existing poles will require double strapping. The cost of the

double strapping is incidental to the replacement sign.
