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## PROPOSAL SCHEDULE

If the bid price for any proposal item having a maximum allowable bid indicated therefore in any of the contract documents is in excess of such a maximum amount, the bid price for such proposal item shall be adjusted to reflect the limitation thereon. The comparison of bids to determine the successful bidder and the amount of contract to be awarded shall be determined after such adjustments are made, and such adjustments shall be binding upon the bidder.

The "SUM OF ALL ITEMS" will be used to determine the lowest responsible bidder.

Notes:

- 1. Bids shall include all Federal, State, County and other applicable taxes and fees.
- 2. If a discrepancy occurs between unit bid price and the bid price, the unit bid price shall govern.
- 3. Bid prices are for travel time, mileage and furnishing all labor, tools, applicable taxes, fees, shipping & delivery costs, direct and indirect costs and equipment necessary for all work shown and called for in accordance with the true intent and meaning of the specifications.
- 4. The services for this contract shall be furnished on an "as needed" basis as required by the State. The estimated quantities specified do not signify a maximum or minimum quantity.
- 5. Bidders shall make no changes to the items in the Proposal Schedule. Altered proposal schedules will be rejected. Only provide bid prices and totals where space is provided. Failure to provide bid prices and totals may result in rejection of bid.
- 6. The "Approx. Quantity" on the Proposal Schedule reflects a typical quantity for each repair location, to be used for bidding purposes.
