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5 If the bid price for any proposal item having a maximum allowable bid  
6 indicated therefore in any of the contract documents is in excess of such a  
7 maximum amount, the bid price for such proposal item shall be adjusted to reflect  
8 the limitation thereon. The comparison of bids to determine the successful bidder  
9 and the amount of contract to be awarded shall be determined after such  
10 adjustments are made, and such adjustments shall be binding upon the bidder.

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12 The "Sum of All Items" will be used to determine the lowest responsible  
13 bidder.

17 1. Bid prices are for travel time, mileage and furnishing all labor, tools,  
18 traffic controls, all applicable taxes, fees and equipment necessary  
19 for all work shown and called for in accordance with the true intent  
20 and meaning of the specifications.  
21  
22 2. Any contract which is awarded shall be an open-ended contract since  
23 the exact value of work to be performed during the contract period  
24 cannot be determined beforehand. The unit price for each item of  
25 work on any particular work order shall be that which corresponds to  
26 the quantity of work for that item actually performed for each work  
27 order.  
28  
29 3. The sum of all work and materials required to perform the required  
30 repairs are issued on a "single work order." A single work order shall  
31 be a work order submitted by the Engineer for work that can be  
32 performed by the Contractor without relocating a distance of more  
33 than 1 mile between any two adjacent repair locations.

35 4. The "Approx. Quantity" on the proposal schedule is for bidding  
36 purposes only, and this is no guarantee of the quantity of work that  
37 will be issued.
