The following amendments shall be made to the Bid Documents:

A. NOTICE TO BIDDERS


1. Hazmat license for Hazardous material such as asbestos pipe and lead based paint located on bathroom tiles.

B. PRE-BID MEETING MINUTES (Started @ 9:20pm due to 1 Bidder Showing up)

1. Read Scope of work for The Motor Vehicle Safety Office Renovation
2. Contractor needs to meet all requirements of material / brands etc. uses and any substitutions of material not available must be of equal or exceeds original material quality and brand. Nature of government building project manufacturers cannot be specified out unless 3 manufacturers are listed (procurement issue).
3. Non-Mandatory job walk for the contractors will be held on June 5, 2014 at 9:00am at the MVSO Job site location.
4. Apprenticeship Agreements as noted on NB-2 of the Special Provisions of the subject project.
5. Contractor removing the Hazardous material such as asbestos pipe and lead paint tile work should be by a professional with a Hazmat license to perform the work. All work shall be done in accordance with the special provisions.
6. Contractor must meet all requirements of environmental issues including best management practices (BMP) – i.e.,: storage of equipment, ingress and egress to the site etc.. Shawn, even though the work is being done on-site, I believe BMPs are going to be monitored (i.e., non-permitted jobs)

7. Submittals must be submitted in a priority fashion to where the amount of submittals at one time does not over whelm the " system of DOT approval "
8. Went over proposal schedule and bid alternative. Dan Bittner and I talked about removing the roof alternatives and going force account if it goes over allotment cap.
