All traffic control work shall conform with the current <u>State</u> Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge and Public Works Construction - 1994 of the Hawaii Department of Transportation, except as otherwise provided on the Plans or the Special Provisions.

3. The Contractor may close only one lane at a time for any reason. During the peak traffic periods from 6:30 AM to 8:30 AM and from 3:30 PM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday, all lanes shall be kept open and maintained at all

- 5. Work on any State facility may be performed only between the hours of 8:30 AM and 3:30 PM, Monday through Friday, unless otherwise permitted by the Hawaii Department of Transportation — Highways Division.
- 6. During working hours, the Contractor shall provide two lanes of through traffic. On streets too narrow to make this practical, the Contractor may work in one half of the roadway keeping one lane open to traffic and alternating the flow of traffic. During non-working hours, all trenches shall be covered with a safe, non-skid, traffic bearing bridging material and all lanes shall be open to traffic.
