



- 3. NO PERMIT SHALL ALLOW ANY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES WHICH EMIT NOISE IN EXCESS OF THE MAXIMUM PERMISSIBLE SOUND LEVELS ON SUNDAYS AND ON HOLIDAYS.


