1. This project consists of installing a 6-foot high chain-link fence along the Likeline Highway median from the vicinity of Bishop Museum to School Street.
2. The existence and location of underground utilities, manholes and structures, as shown on the plans, are from the latest available data but is not guaranteed as to accuracy or completeness. The Contractor shall be responsible and shall pay for all damages to existing utilities resulting from his operations.
3. The Contractor shall keep all existing traffic lanes open to public traffic during the peak traffic hours and periods of non-work. During the peak traffic hours, the Contractor shall not perform any work which would inconvenience traffic flow or obstruct any of the existing traffic lanes. Such work includes, but is not limited to, the movement of equipment, machinery and materials. Peak traffic hours shall be from 6:00 A.M. to 8:30 A.M. and from 3:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M. The peak hours are subject to change by the Engineer.
4. The Contractor shall limit his construction operations to the area within the Highway Right of Way.
5. No material or equipment shall be stored where it will interfere with the free and safe passage of public traffic. At the end of each day's work or when construction operations are suspended for any reason, the Contractor shall remove all equipment and other obstructions to permit free and safe passage of public traffic.
6. Traffic incidental to other highway and bridge construction projects which are adjacent to, at the ends of, or on the principal routes of travel to or past the work contracted to be performed shall be deemed to be part of the general public traffic and shall be accommodated as required by the provisions of the contract.
7. The Contractor shall protect carefully from disturbance or damage all land monuments and property marks until the Engineer has witnessed or otherwise referenced their location and shall not move them until directed.
8. If the Contractor learns from either the owner of the utility or from any other source of the existence and location of properties of utility companies either omitted from or shown incorrectly on the plans, the Contractor shall not disturb the utilities and shall immediately notify the Engineer who will advise him as to the actions to be taken.
9. Lane closures during non-peak hours shall conform to these plans and specifications and will not be paid for separately but will be considered incidental to the chain link fence item.
